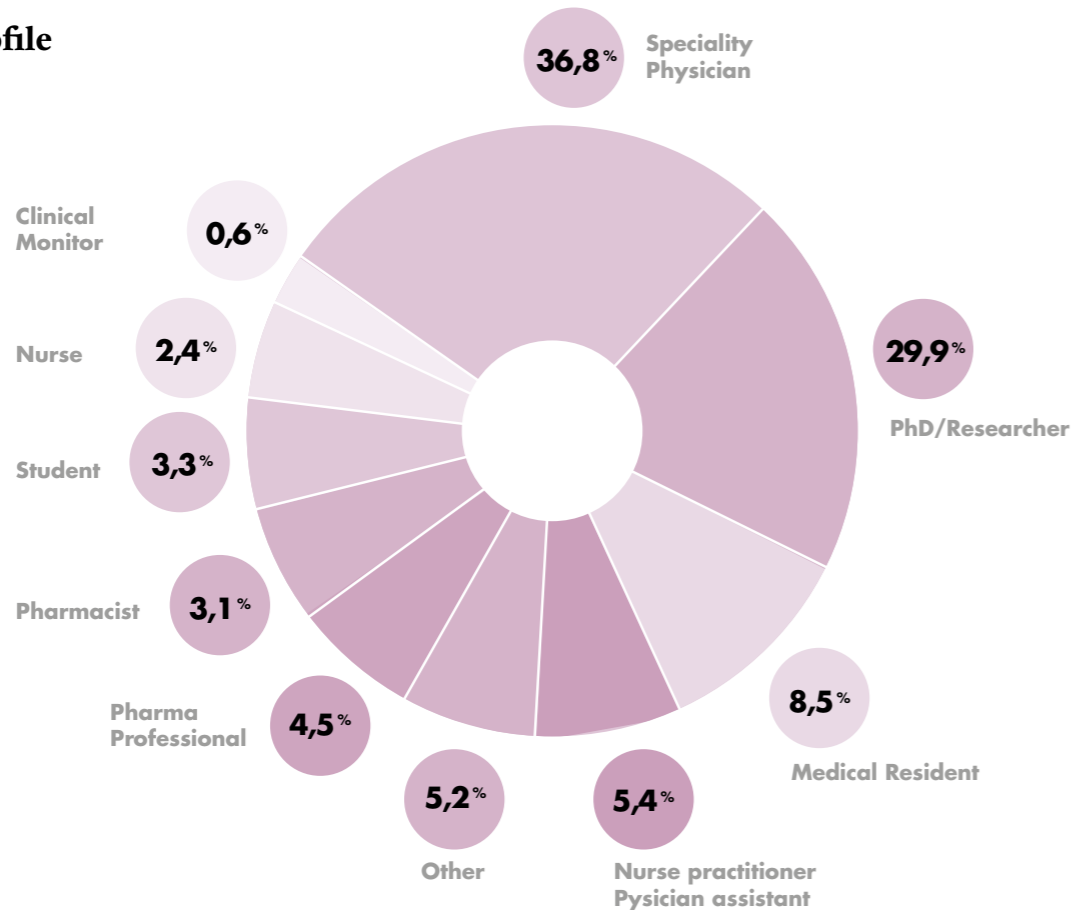

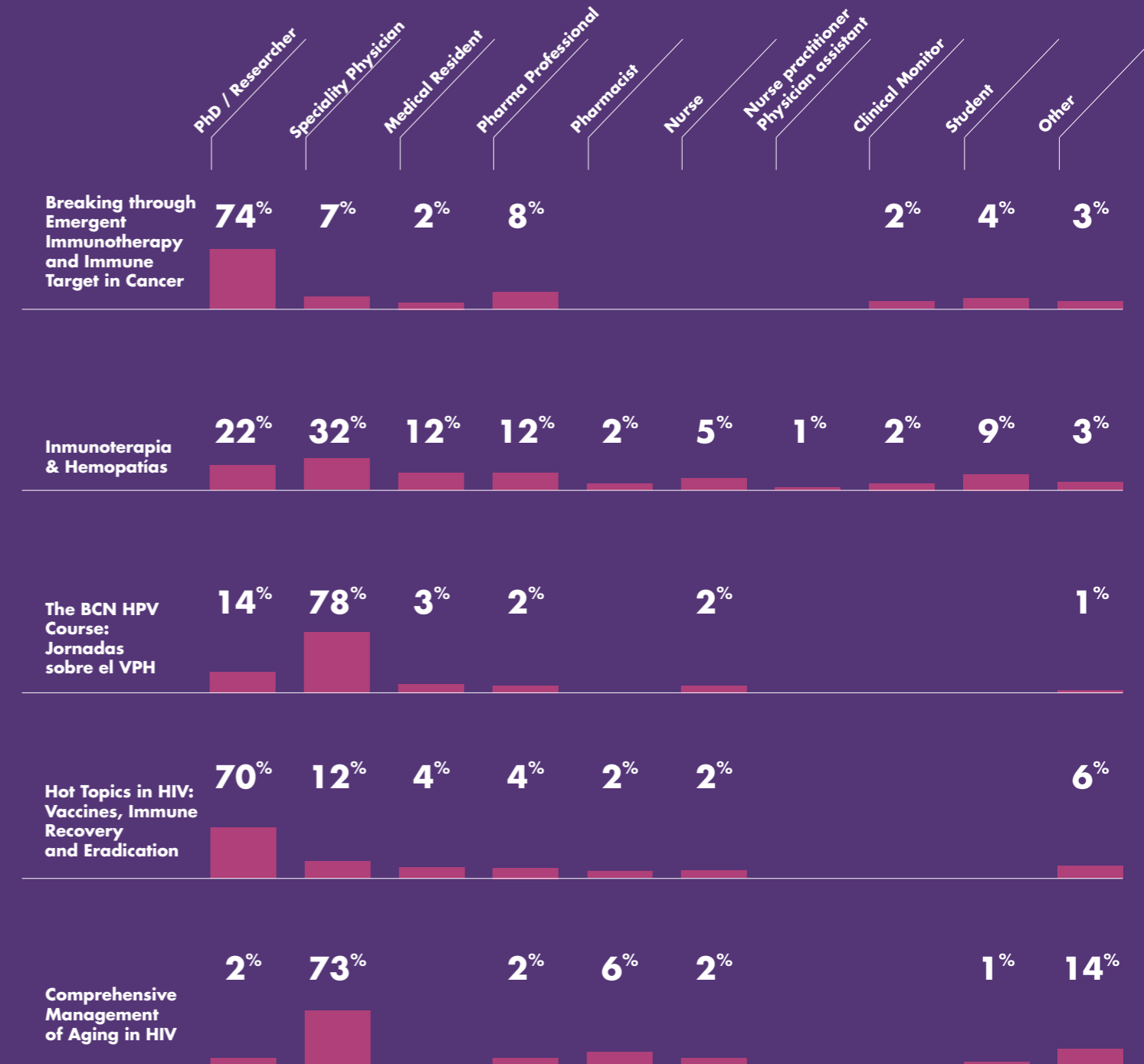
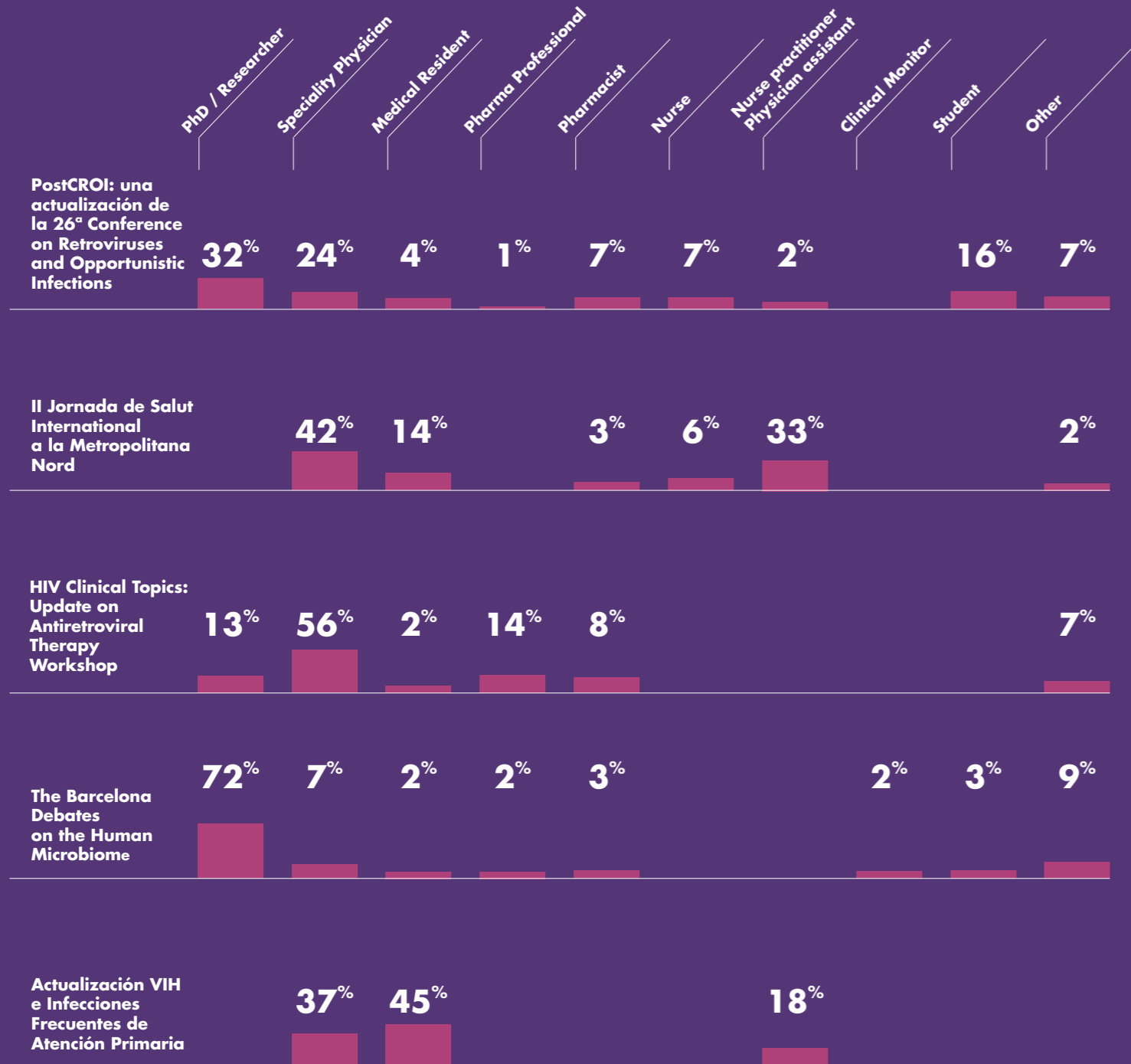
### Comprehensive Management of Aging in HIV

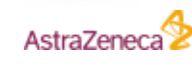
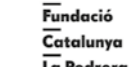
